'Robert Dunlop Of Clober'

Seal features Dunlop arms, motto - 'Merito', and the initials 'RD' Robert Dunlop of Clober was the father of Alexander and John (d 1873) and a daughter Janet. Alexander and John travelled through North America during 1831-1834. John Dunlop of Brocklock, Ayrshire, (d 1873) married Isabella Brown, the daughter of Reverend Dr William Brown (d 1863). He died in 1873.

The salamander motif indicates 'of Glenbervie', and the seal matrix may have belonged to Alexander Douglas, 7<sup>th</sup> Baronet, of Glenbervie (1738 – 1812)


