John Fane, 10th Earl of Westmorland, KG, PC

British Tory politician, served in most of the cabinets of the period, most notably as Lord Privy Seal.

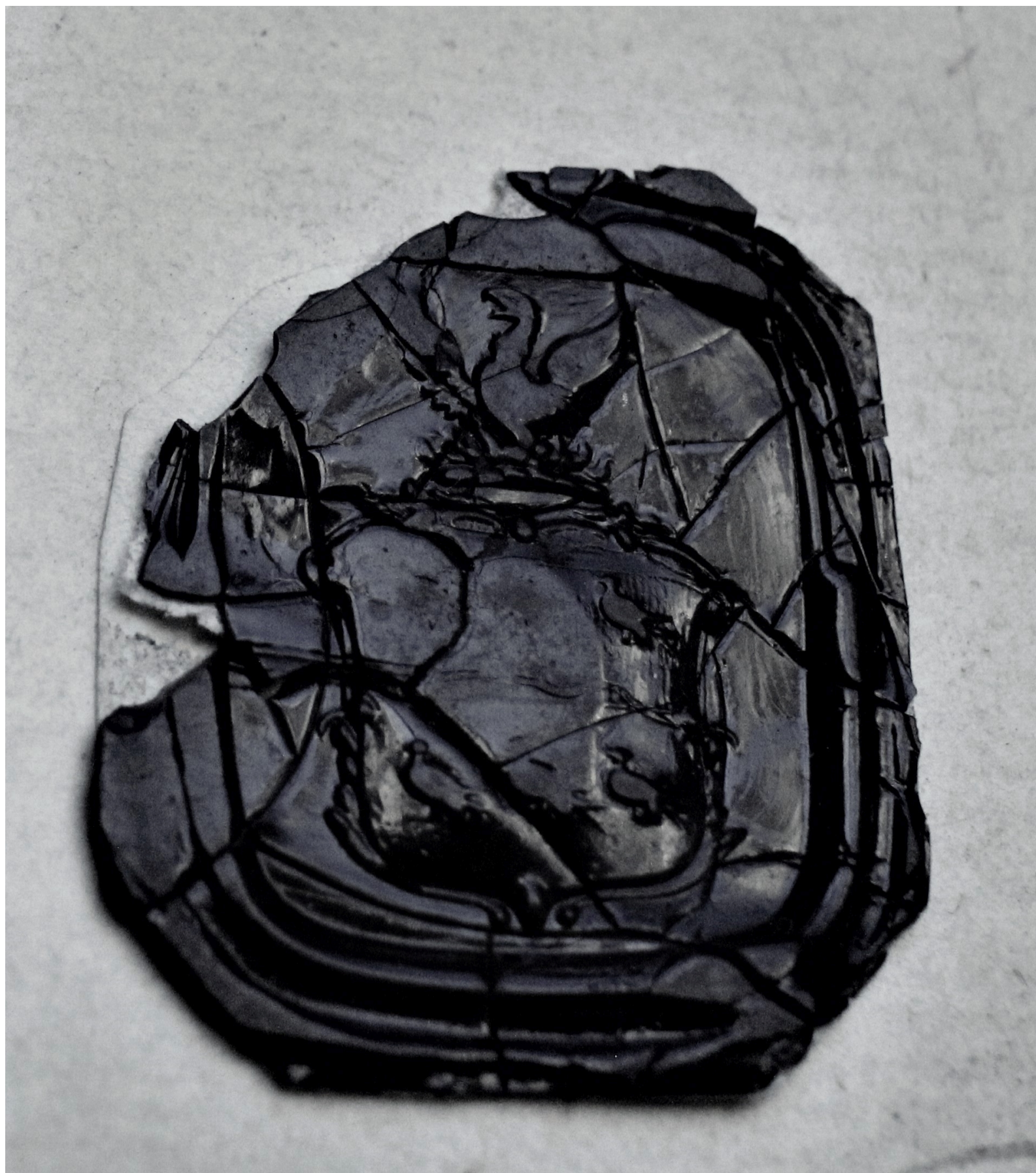
