Leith, Town of, 1563

This is a copy of the Seal of Leith which dates from 1563, when Mary Queen of Scots was supporting Leith's ambition to become an independent Burgh. Leith was historically a separate town, only merging with Edinburgh on 1<sup>st</sup> November 1920.

Admiral Sir Thomas Livingstone of Bedlormie and Westquarter,  
7<sup>th</sup> Knight Baronet of Nova Scotia.

Tuscany, Prince of Hungary & Bohemia & Archduke of Austria  
1788’

Leopold II, Holy Roman Emperor (Peter Leopold Josef Anton  
Joachim Pius Gotthard),

Holy Roman Emperor, King of Hungary and Bohemia, Archduke  
of Austria from 1790 to 1792, and Grand Duke of Tuscany from  
1765 to 1790.

5 May 1747 – 1 March 1792)

‘Laurie’

The most likely identity is that of Sir Robert Laurie, 5th Baronet  
(c. 1738 – 1804)
